

following up:
1. Messages. I repeated my mantra that we are launching a national project to stop the spread of the infection by creating a populatoin-wide commitment to isolating yourself if you have symptoms or if you are asked to. Note, it is not a "product launch", it is not a "service launch" (which is how it is written at the moment). It is an invitation to participate in a

2. the stakeholder piece seems very bitty and needs umph. Ive asked for a (a) script, which has been asked for before, and needs to happen, and (b) a target stakeholder list (by catagory, not by name) so that we can match groups with people. Ive asked for a big Whitehall call on Friday to key people to run through the script so that they are prepared to contact their stakeholders on Tuesday. Note, this will eventually lead to a big of leakiness, but i personally dont think this matters, please raise a flag if you are concerned.

3. in terms of sequencing, I am assuming that the "service" elements of the programme will be dealt with in the Sundays, and what is presented on Wednesday is a massive Prime Ministeral call to action. We need to tee-up this by getting stakeholders bought into the vision in advance. Therefore, we need #10 comforatable with this seqencing. Pls confirm that you are ok to sell this in. or if you have concerns.

Just as a heads-up. I had a catch-up with conversation with from testing, from CMO, from Social Care and others.

There is an outstanding sub on prioritisation of social care testing. It emerged there are quite a few outstanding practical challenges (like getting older people to get tests), demand issues (some hard-to-reach homes that have not responded to requests for testing), and epidemiological (particularly, how we prioritise 30/40k tests a day against a theoretical demand of 160pd). My overall impression is that there is huge progress, but also much much more to do. I think we need someone from social care embedded in the testing regime of testing.

Thanks to those on the impromptu mini-session just now. Key points:-

- 4. I gather that has a good comms effort to make sure local responses to outbreaks and isolation-notices. This is critical. Really important this works ok.

 5. Recognition that NHS remains an area of concern. There's an agreement that local DPH's will have an important external-guidance role in managing infection, and it's important this agreement is socialised and explained, and someone takes management of the comms element of DPHs as they are enthusiastically independent and therefore may need clear counsel on press management.
